






WORKSHOP ON "DIY INSTRUCTIONAL VIDEO — PART 1"

This hands-on workshop was facilitated by Prof. Dr. Abd Karim Alias, aimed to empower UNITEN academics with the expertise to produce and seamlessly incorporate impactful instructional videos into their teaching. Participants learned to define learning objectives, craft engaging scripts, select suitable video formats, and gain practical experience in video recording and editing using free applications, including exploring generative AI tools. Additionally, they developed strategies for delivering clear and engaging content on camera and integrating their newly created videos into existing lesson plans. Among the AI tools covered during the workshop were Veed.IO, Loom, Invideo, Canva, Lumen5 and Streamable.
